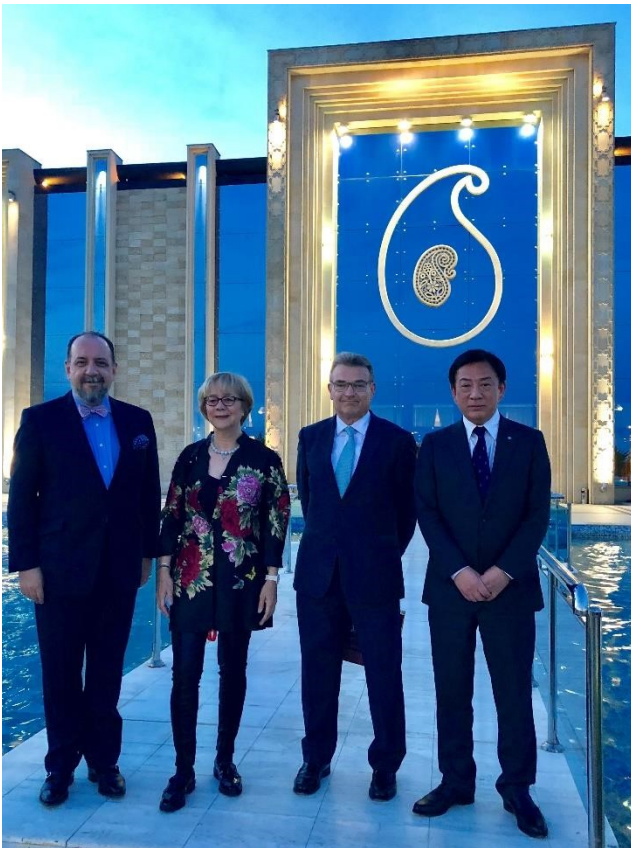


Masamichi Morooka, President & CEO, spoke about LNG bunkering and Green Incentives on IAPH Baku 2018
