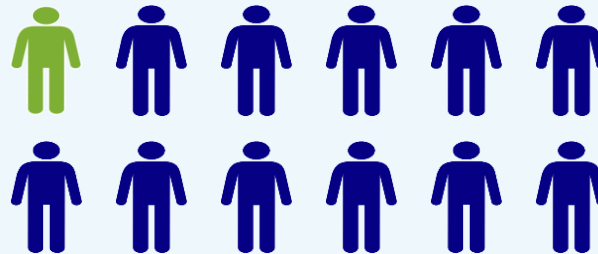

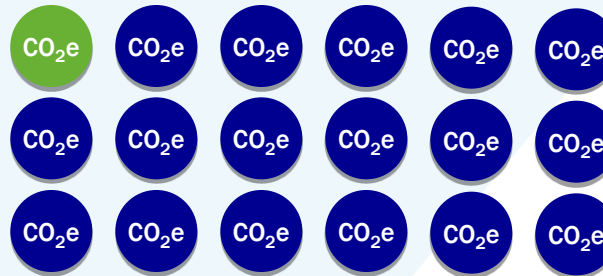

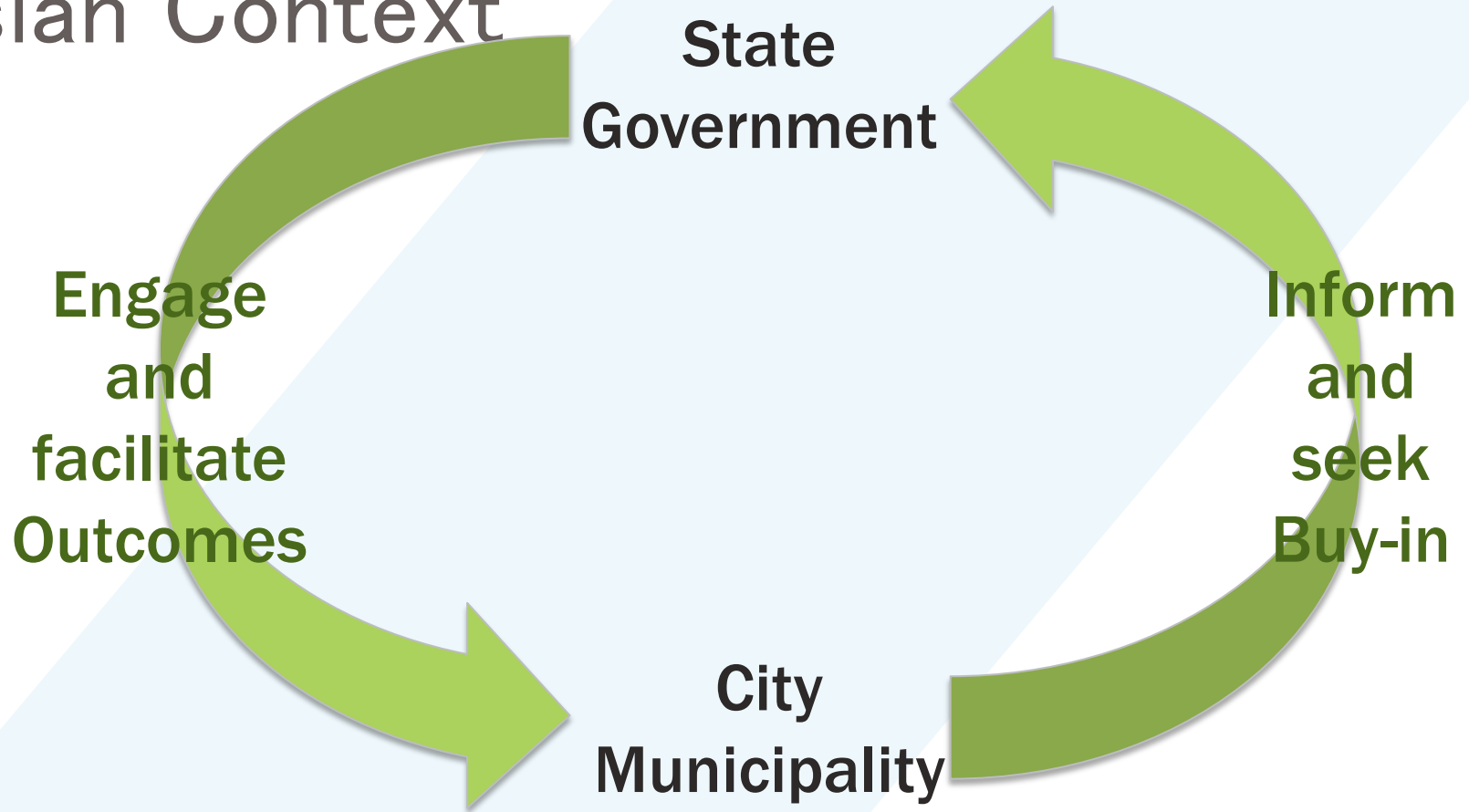

City Expansion in South Asia and West Asia



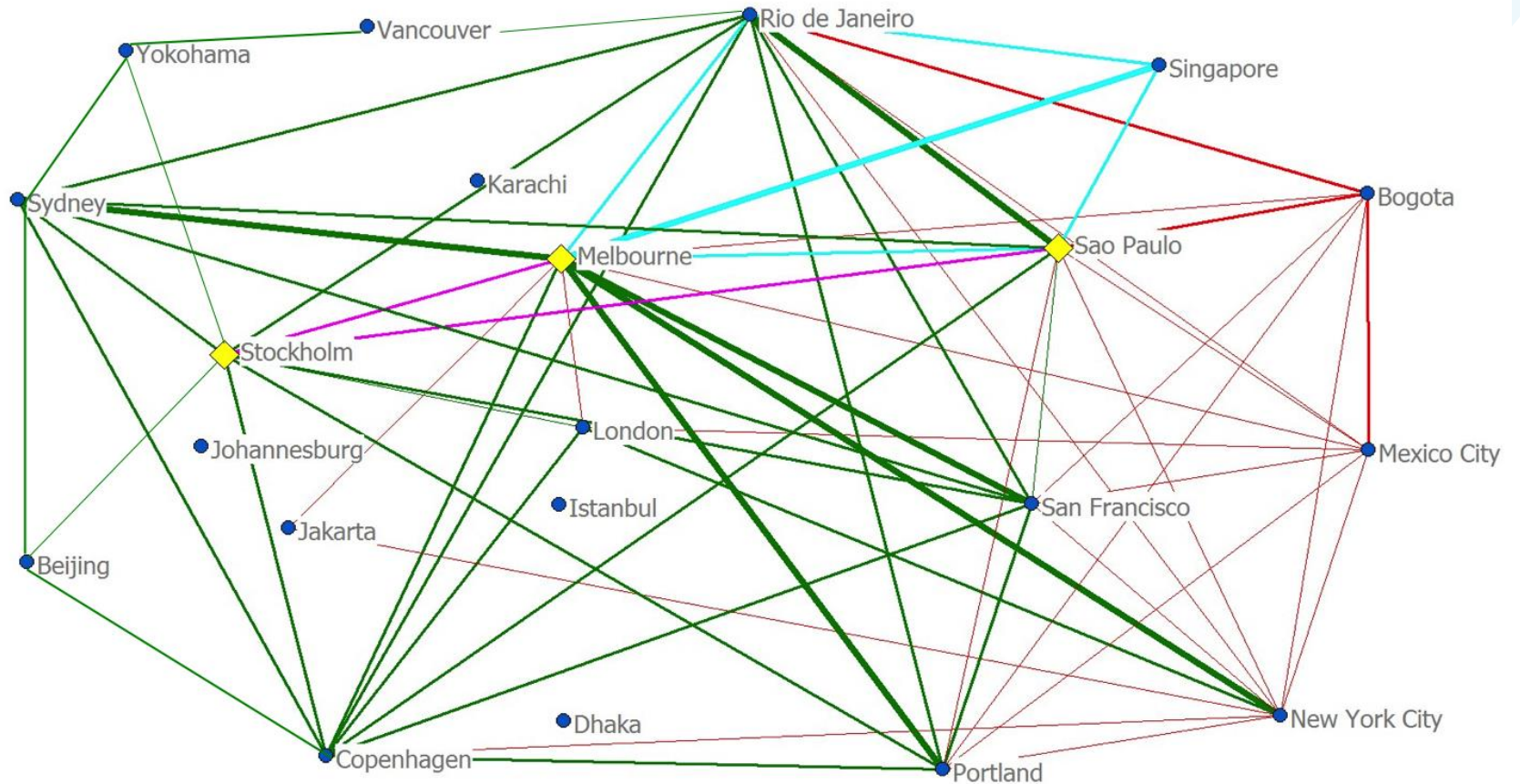


